YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Education Income Tax Credit

In Pennsylvania, businesses enrolled in the Department of Community and Economic Development's Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program (EITC) can contribute to YGBW's educational programs and receive a tax credit ranging from 75% to 100% the gifted amount! YGBW is currently registered for two program options: Pre-K Scholarships, which supports Childcare and Early Learning Center tuition for children aged 3–6 from lower income households across all YGBW branches, and the Educational Improvement Organization (EIO) Program at the Upper Main Line YMCA, which supplements environmental education and STEM academic instruction in both the Great Valley and Tredyffrin-Easttown School Districts.

7th Grade Initiative

We offer to all Chester County seventh graders a free membership. As kids face adolescence's challenges, they are more likely to begin distancing themselves from formal organizations, friends and family and to experiment with unhealthy behaviors. The 7th Grade Initiative offers an alternative where they can make new friends, discover their passions and develop a healthy lifestyle.

Safety Around Water

Accidental drowning is the leading cause of death for children under the age of 15. Our Safety Around Water program provides free swim instruction to children, in partnership with their school district or community group, which teaches life-saving skills and opens a world of possibilities for them to safely satisfy their curiosity. Our trained instructors lead groups of students through stations focused on basic water safety skills such as how to wear a lifejacket, how to identify risks around the water, basic flotation, basic movement and more.



Y Achievers

The Achievers program is dedicated to empowering youth in grades 5th–12th by fostering academic and career success. This initiative focuses on shaping young minds, instilling strong character, a robust work ethic, and emphasizing the significance of education. Alongside academic development, Achievers places a spotlight on leadership and skills enhancement, providing tools to cultivate positive behavioral traits such as caring, honesty, respect, responsibility, and self-confidence.

The YMCA Achievers Program is designed to educate youth in various fields, including business, technology, communication skills, finance, commerce, law, health, political science, art expression and design. The program also guides youth in navigating the emerging world of cultural diversity and social responsibility. Whether pursuing higher education at a university, community college, or trade/technical college, participants receive dedicated support from YMCA staff and volunteers. High school student participants experience increased graduation rates and acceptance to institutions of higher learning, while middle school participants acquire the skills necessary for enhanced academic achievement as they transition into high school.

HEALTHY LIVING

LIVESTRONG® at the YMCA

The LIVE**STRONG**® program was established in partnership with the LIVE**STRONG**® Foundation to assist those who are living with, through or beyond cancer to strengthen their spirit, mind and body. This evidence-based program is 12 weeks and includes cardiovascular conditioning, strength training, balance and flexibility exercises as well as support sessions and is free to all who qualify with permission to do so from their doctor.

Adaptive

The Y believes that in a diverse world we are stronger when we are inclusive, when our doors are open to all and when everyone has the opportunity to learn, grow and thrive. We are proud to offer a variety of adaptive programming at all our branches for children and adults with unique abilities. They range from recreational/social groups like Open Doors, Respite Recreation, or LEGO club, to athletic and fitness-based programs such as adaptive swim, sports, dance, gymnastics/tumbling, adaptive pickleball clinics and small group fitness and even an adaptive day camp program called Bumblebee Day Camp


