Project Focus: Night to Shine, a prom night experience for individuals with disabilities, organized annually by the Tim Tebow Foundation. For many years, participants in our adaptive programs have attended this unforgettable event, which fosters inclusion, joy, and self-esteem for individuals who may not always have access to such celebrations. This prom has a profound impact, offering attendees a chance to shine and feel celebrated in a space designed for their enjoyment and dignity.

Project Goal: Make event cheer posters and flowers to create a beautiful evening for the participants attending the Night to Shine pre-party.

Project Due Date: Return all finished items to your home branch by January 31st.

Option 1: Create Posters to cheer on guests as they walk from the pre-party to the bus to travel to the event.

- Materials Needed: Poster board, makers/stickers/glitter etc.
- Theme inspiration: Lights, stars, fireworks, the night sky, movie star red carpet, senior prom, winter formal
- Phrase ideas:
 - Every day you shine bright!
 - Have a blast tonight!
 - You are beautiful!
 - Keep that smile dazzling all night long!
 - This is YOUR night!
 - You are amazing!



Option 2: Create Paper Flowers for use as a corsage, boutonniere, decoration for pre-party decorations.

- Materials Needed: Paper, pipe cleaners, ribbon
- Suggested tutorial: [Kids Craft: Tissue Paper Flowers](#)
 - 4 sheets of tissue paper (2 in one color, 2 in another color)
 - Cut in rectangles of 4 by 8 inches
 - Zig Zag Fold, then Zig Zag cut on both ends
 - Pipe cleaner around the middle, then fluff and open up petals
 - Store safely!
